Players of the Week

****Pitcher:** RHP Drew Naylor, Lakewood. 1-0 for 1 start, stretching his winning streak to 5 in a row. In the 6-1 complete game win over Delmarva on Thursday, Naylor struck out a career-high 13. His 91 strikeouts for the season are tops in the South Atlantic League and second in all of minor league baseball. Over his last 10 starts, he is 5-0 with a 2.47 ERA and 71 strikeouts. Naylor, 22, from Melbourne, Australia, was the Pitcher of the Week for April 28-May 4 this year and twice last season at Williamsport.

****Player:** 3B Brennan King, Lehigh Valley. In 6 games, he batted .400 with 10 hits, 5 RBI and 6 runs. He had 1 double and 2 home runs. The 6 games extended his consecutive errorless streak to 42 games. The 27-year-old is a former second-round selection of the Dodgers who is in his third year with the Phillies.

Hitting streaks that ended: Jaramillo, 13 games on Saturday; DH Mike Cervenak, 18 games on Wednesday and SS Mike Rouse, 9 games on Thursday . . . LHP Brian Mazone gave up 1 run in 6 innings on Friday but saw his 6-game winning streak end . . . LHP J. A. Happ leads International League with 81 strikeouts. He fanned 10 in a Thursday win (7.2 innings) . . . RHP Matt Childers, 1-0 for 3 appearances, 0 runs, 4 innings, 6 strikeouts.

1-5 . . . INF Neil Sellers batted .438 in 5 games . . . OF Jeremy Slayden, .400 in 4 games . . . OF Mike Spidale extended his hitting streak to 13 games . . . CF Greg Golson, who hit .336 in May, is hitless in June (25 at-bats) . . . LHP Antonio Bastardo pitched hitless ball for 6.1 innings at Trenton on Friday; he walked 6 and struck out 8 and wasn't involved in the decision.

4-2 . . . 2B Adrian Cardenas batted .370 and led the organization with 5 stolen bases. He hasn't been caught in 7 attempts . . . 1B Clay Harris had 3 doubles and 2 homers among 7 hits . . . SS Fidel Hernandez had a 9-game hitting streak (.412) end on Thursday . . . RHP Brian Schlitter was 1-0 in 2 appearances, stretching a scoreless streak to 5 straight games; in last 10 games, 3-1, 2 saves, 0.50 ERA . . . RHP Tyson Brummett won his first game at Clearwater on Saturday, retiring 20 of 21 hitters at one point . . . RH closer Sam Walls hasn't allowed a run over last 13 appearances (18 innings) with 8 saves, 7 hits, 5 walks and 23 strikeouts and he didn't make the Florida State League Western Division All-Star squad.

LF Michael Taylor had 2 homers to tie teammate Michael Durant and LV 1B Andy Tracy for most among Phillies minor leaguers (10) . . . 2B-DH Derrick Mitchell, .333; he's hit in 11 of his last 13 games (.405), 4 homers, 14 RBI . . . 1B Matt Rizzotti, .333, with club-high 4 doubles . . . OF T. J. Warren joined Lakewood on May 22 and hit in first 12 games in which he played; streak ended Sunday . . . RHP Jared Simon, 2 saves, giving him 10 for the season, matching Reading's Pat Overholt and Clearwater's Sam Walls for the organization-high.
